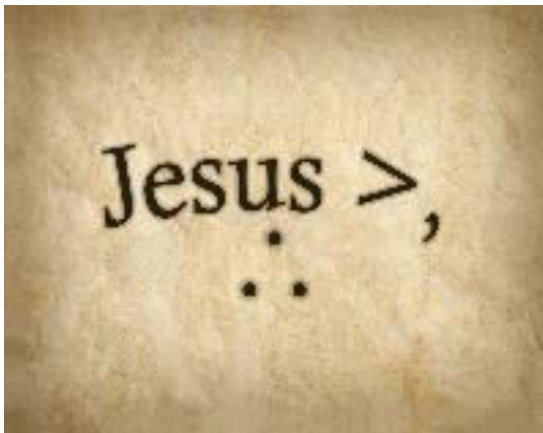
Once again, Limehouse Presbyterian is hosting a pot luck supper with elements of a Passover meal. Communion will be part of the meal. Please join us.
